Note: Please ensure that your Adventurer or Master Guide Club is registered with the Ontario Conference this current year before registering for camporee. Club registration fee is \$35 only (\$45 after Jan. 31st) and insurance fee per person is \$4.50, which insures your Adventurers/MGs/ MGTs and staff as they take part in your club activities within a 12-month period.

Remember, this is a pre-requisite for your club to be allowed to join the I AM Camporee. If your club is not registered with the conference yet, your camporee registration will be returned. Deadline for the yearly club registration: **February 29, 2020.**

Also, your club staff and volunteers should do the Vulnerable Sector Screening required to all church leaders/volunteers who work with children and youth.

- Keep right at the fork to continue on ON-403 W, follow signs for QEW via Ontario 403/Hamilton
- Take exit 27 for ON-24 S/Rest Acres Road S toward Simcoe
- Turn left onto Rest Acres Rd/ON-24 S
- Turn left onto Robinson Rd
- Slight right onto Jennings Rd.
- Entrance to Brant Park Conservation Area (# 119) is on the left side
- Follow signs to group camping sites 701-703

From the West:

- Get on 401 E to 403 E
- Continue on 403 E and take exit 27 for ON-24 S/Rest Acres Road S toward Simcoe
- Turn left onto Rest Acres Rd/ON-24 S
- Turn left onto Robinson Rd
- Slight right onto Jennings Rd.
- Entrance to Brant Park Conservation Area (# 119) is on the left side
- Follow signs to group camping sites 701-703



- 1. Present to your church board your club's plan to attend and participate in the *I AM* Camporee to be held on August 5-9, 2020. See to it that this said date is included in your church's calendar of events for 2020.
- 2. Be prompt in submitting your 2020 strategic plan to your pastor(s) and church board for their approval. Include a budget proposal which shows estimated income (from individual fees, fundraising, and local church subsidy) and expenses such as food, transportation, first aid kit, camping materials, etc. Don't forget to thank your pastor and church board members for their moral and financial support.
- Promote the *I AM Camporee* to all Adventurer families, Master Guides (MGs), and Master Guide Trainees (MGTs) in your church. (Note: Master Guides serving in Adventurer, Masterguide, & Pathfinder [AMP] Ministries are welcome to register and attend). Kindly place the *I AM Camporee* poster strategically on your church bulletin board.
- 4. Organize the following committees to be comprised of staff, parents, and other volunteers: fundraising, transportation, food service, security, first aid, camp equipment, etc.
- 5. Start your fundraising! Plan out how you will raise funds over the months leading up to the camporee. Check out our website for ideas.
- Register your club as soon as possible. (Note: Only Adventurers who will be accompanied by their parent[s] or <u>legal</u> guardians will be allowed to register). Kindly complete the registration form (in excel format) and email to <u>ehabaradas@adventistontario.org</u>. Don't wait for the last minute to submit your registration.
- 7. Check with your Pathfinder club of your church if they can possibly lend you their canopy, tents, First Aid kits, fire extinguisher, coolers, generators, etc. For safety reasons, repair or replace worn out or broken supplies.
- 8. All staff should have their Vulnerable Sector Screening done at the start of the Adventurer or Master Guide program year. Just see to it that all staff and volunteers who will join the camporee have complied with this requirement.
- 9. All campers, both young and old, should fill out the Medical Info and Liability Release form, as well as the Videography/Photography Release Record. Put them in a binder.
- 10. Meal times are short so you can save a lot of time and energy if you have volunteers to cook for your club. Thus, it is recommended that you organize a kitchen crew; just be mindful of other individuals with different dietary needs. Remember, volunteers need to register for camporee and pay the appropriate registration fee as well.
- 11. Keep your club staff and members well informed about the camporee and share information with them as you receive it. - 12. Sit with your Adventurer or MG staff months before the camporee and discuss what they might like to do while at camp such as awards/honours, daytime activities, etc. Planning ahead of time will get your Adventurers and MGTs involved and excited about what they will be doing once they get to camporee.
- 13. One week before the camporee, meet with all your MG/Adv staff and Adventurer parents to finalize your packing list, club rules, and club activities/schedule for what your club plans

to do at camporee.

- 14. Prepare a binder where you can put all camporee information for easy reference while at camporee.
- 15. As you plan well for camp set-up, plan also for camp takedown and clean up at the end of camporee. Kindly leave your campsite cleaner than when you first found it. Your MG or Adventurer coordinator will inspect your site first before you will be allowed to leave camp on Sunday, August 10, 2020.

If chosen by the Program Committee, the Adventurer's parents or MGT will be notified of their performance schedule. Unless otherwise instructed, the same song or type of presentation as shown in the video demo will be presented at camporee.

Club First Aid Team

Each church/club is required to have its own First Aid Team to deal with minor cuts and bruises, and other minor cases. (Note: A church with both ADV and MG clubs can have 1 First Aid Team only). For cases that the club's First Aid Team could not handle, the patient should be brought to the Camporee First Aid Station for medical assessment. And it will be the camporee nurse's discretion to either call 911 or simply send the patient to the nearest hospital.

Heatth & Safety

At Camporee, the safety of all campers is our number 1 priority. In view of this, the following safety rules must be observed by all campers:

- 1. The *I AM Camporee* staff is responsible for establishing a supervised First Aid Station on the campground; this will be staffed, on a rotation basis, by volunteer medical personnel.
- 2. Each club is responsible for the timely and proper disposal of all garbage from the campsite.
- 3. Each club must follow established procedures for the disposal of gray water from the campsite.
- 4. Food must **NOT** be stored in the sleeping tents during the night.
- 5. Peanuts and/or peanut products should **NOT** be brought to Camporee in consideration of people who could have an allergic reaction to these products.

- 6. Ignitable materials, lighted candles, stoves, heaters or lanterns are prohibited in tents used as living quarters or unattended storage space. Any of the above equipment, while in use outside the tents, should not be left unattended.
- 7. All campfires will be at the discretion of the local camp authorities and will be at the designated areas only. All fires must be **totally extinguished** by dousing with water before retiring for the night.
- 8. **<u>Do not Use</u>** petroleum products for starting fires.
- 9. Each club should have a FIRE EXTINGUISHER (A.B.C. rated) on site. This is one of the points of consideration when your campsite is inspected.
- 10. <u>No</u> swimming is allowed outside of the designated area and time.
- 11. Hiking outside of the designated campgrounds must be supervised.

Wristbands

All registered campers, parents, staff members' children, and 24-hour pass visitors are required to wear wristbands issued to them. Without the wristbands, no one will be allowed to enter the campsite or take part in camporee activities. **It is a MUST** that wristbands are worn **at all times** while at camp.

- 3. Cover email/letter containing contact information (name, full mailing address, email address, daytime telephone number/cell phone number, and church/club membership) for the composer(s).

Selection Process

All submissions received by the deadline will be reviewed by the I AM Camporee Committee. The process should be completed and applicants notified of final decision by June 18, 2020. Winning entry will be announced via the <u>www.camporee.ca</u> website.

Use of Selected Song

The selected song will be used as theme song for the 2020 / AM Camporee. In addition, the successful composer(s) will be invited to perform the song live at the opening ceremonies on August 5, 2020.

Please note that the Ontario Conference must have the right to use or perform the selected song in any format at any time without the need for permission from or compensation paid to the composer or other copyright holder. If the finalist cannot meet these conditions, then another song may be selected.

Prize

The composer of the winning entry will receive a trophy and free admission to the I AM Camporee in Brantford, ON.
